

Resetting and replacement Electronic knob ELS & ENiQ Pro

Q: What do I have to do to replace the body of an ENiQ Pro or ELS Pro?

A: During replacement of **ENiQ Pro -> ELS Pro** electronics, the cylinder must be decoupled using the following steps:

- 1. The cylinder must be decoupled from the system via Device Management.
- 2. The ELS Pro electronics may only be fitted to the body assembly after this has taken place.
- **3.** First initialisation (marrying) of the ELS Pro electronics with the body assembly using the **ELS master card**.

Note on the controller: the cylinder now flashes blue (as with an RF wake-up card) when a transponder is presented.

A: During replacement of **ELS Pro -> ENiQ Pro** electronics, this must take place via the master card using the following steps:

- Remove knob cap
- 2. Unplug battery
- 3. Position the master card in the cylinder reading field
- 4. Insert the battery and wait until the cylinder flashes red and green alternately
- 5. Unplug the battery again
- 6. Remove the cylinder from the reading field of the master card
- 7. Insert the battery again
 - Note on the controller: the cylinder now flashes blue (as with an RF wake-up card) when a transponder is presented
- 8. Couple by means of ENiQ Device Management
